POLICY

McIntosh Trail CSB policies reflect the belief that the consumer has the right to personal privacy and security. These rights are ensured and protected within the constraint of the treatment/service plan.

Full information is given to the consumer on the current and future use of special observation and audio visual techniques, such as one-way vision mirrors, audio/video tape recorders, television, movies, or photographs. Written consent is required before recording, filming, taping or using one-way mirror whether used by the internal organization or external organization (Consent to Use Special Observation and Audio Visual Techniques).

Anyone who engages in recording or filming (who is not already bound by the organization's confidentiality policy) signs a confidentiality statement to protect the consumers' identity and confidential information (Consent to Use Special Observation and Audio Visual Techniques).
