POLICY

It is the policy of McIntosh Trail CSB that individuals can be suspended from receiving services if they violate program guidelines or interfere with another individuals attempt to receive services.

PROCEDURE

Individuals can be suspended for the following reasons:

1. Violation of another person's rights;
2. Refusal to comply with the Individualized Service Plan (ISP);
3. Behavioral issues:
 - Aggression toward self and/or others;
 - Threats toward self and/or others.
4. Refusal to meet the written requirements for admission to and continued stay criteria within the program;
5. Reinstatement to a program after suspension:
 - After clearance by their primary physician or a psychiatric evaluation by a qualified and licensed individual;

and/or

 - After the interdisciplinary team (Day Program staff, group home representative, support coordinator, etc.) meets to assess the individual for return to services;
6. If needed, an individual may be required by a professional to have a behavioral plan.
